

Across Pilgrimage Holidays Seeking Help: Over the last 47 years, Across has enabled thousands of people enjoy a pilgrimage week in **Lourdes**, travelling on the **Jumbulance**. Jumbulance travel allows people who are unable to fly and those who need specialist medical care throughout, to participate fully in a pilgrimage or holiday. For others, an Across pilgrimage is a special moment in their year, being part of a small group where they make friends and spend time with others. However, due to corona virus pandemic, they have cancelled all 2020 pilgrimage for the safety of their VIPs, helpers and medical volunteers. With no pilgrimage running, they have lost 78% of their annual income. The management is asking **£150** contribution from each parish to sustain the company through the pandemic. **Fr.
